

Panui: Tuesday August 15th, 2017

Tena koutou katoa e te whanau.

Whanau, this week being the beginning of Koroneihana time, we have 3 major events happening that we need you to be aware of. These events are;

- Thursday August 17th: Full School attendance at the Rakaumanga Production: Return to the River
- Monday August 21st: Full school attendance at the Coronation.
- Friday August 18th: Full Nga Taiatea Kapa Haka performance at the Coronation.

Rakaumanga Production: Thursday August 17th: We are fortunate enough that our kura has been invited to a matinee of the latest production, 'Return to the river' on Thursday 17 August at 1pm. The kura will travel to and from kura via buses. There is a charge of \$5 which will cover your child's entry.

We are traveling to Te Wharekura o Raakaumangamanga, Huntly to watch the production. Buses will leave school at 12pm and will return to school by 3.30pm.

Students' are expected to be in their number 1 uniform.

Money is to be paid directly to the school office by waa kai 1, Thursday 17 August. Please be aware that if your child does not pay by Thursday, your child will be charged.

Please note: By sending your child to school on Thursday 17th August you are agreeing that your child can watch 'Return to the river' being held at Te Wharekura o Raakaumangamanga, Huntly. I authorise that should my child take part in this activity, staff may require to access medical services or similar in an event my child falls sick or is involved in an accident. I authorise the obtaining of any medical assistance on my behalf if in the opinion of the staff such treatment is necessary and agree to meet any costs incurred.

Koroneihana Full School Attendance: Monday August 21st: This is a reminder paanui to remind you that the kura will be attending Kiingi Tuheitia 11th Coronation on Monday 21st August.

- Travel Arrangements: We will travel to and from kura on buses and our school vans.
- **Departure:** Monday 21st August, 9am
- **Return:** Monday 21st August, 1.30pm
- **Uniform:** Number ones (no high heels)

There is no cost to students but we ask that they bring their lunch/snack/money and a drink to sustain them throughout the day.

Please note: By sending your child to school on Monday 21st August, you are agreeing that your child can attend Kiingi Tuheitia 11th Coronation being held at Tuurangawaewae Marae, Ngaruawaahia. You authorise that should your child take part in this activity, staff may need to access medical services or similar in an event your child falls sick or is involved in an accident. You authorise the obtaining of any medical assistance on your behalf if in the opinion of the staff such treatment is necessary and agree to meet any costs incurred.

The kura does not take any responsibility or is not liable if any student's devices or personal gear gets broken or is lost/stolen while attend the Coronation of Kiingi Tuheitia.

Kapa Haka Performance at the Coronation: Friday August 18th: Tēnā tātou i ngā tini āhuatanga o te wā.

This pānui is to inform parents about the movements in regards to Koroneihana and the performance our kaihaka will be involved in.

Performance: This performance will take place on Friday the 18th of August at 8.30pm. This performance is for all students who are in the current kapa haka group that practices during Oranga Wairua. We ask all parents and caregivers to take responsibility for organising someone to collect their tamaiti/tamariki at 10pm from the drop off points (Kura or 5 Cross Roads Mc Donalds) at 10pm). Students who are travelling with their own whanau to meet the kapa haka at Turangawaewae at 7.00pm sharp in front of Kimiora (the wharekai) for a practice before the scheduled performance.

Note: Whanau are most welcome to come to Tūrangawaewae to watch the performances and collect their tamaiti/tamariki.

Date:	Friday the 18th of August 2017
Time:	A bus will depart at 6.30pm to go to Turangawaewae – Return by 10pm. Two school vans will leave 5 Cross Roads McDonalds car park at 6.30pm to take students on that side of town and will return to the 5McDonalds by 10pm that evening.
Venue:	Tūrangawaewae Marae.
Attire:	Number One Dress Uniform– Students & Kaiako.

Please note: Depending on how the performance preparation is, we may ask all Kaihaka to stay on after Kura on Friday the 18th of August to prepare for the evenings performance. We will let students know by Wednesday afternoon if we need to stay at school on Friday after school to prepare for the performance. If this is the case, then all of the vans and bus will leave from Nga Taiatea at 6.30pm.
