- Matua Eric Short and Matua Steve Makiri for your support and comittment to our kaupapa.

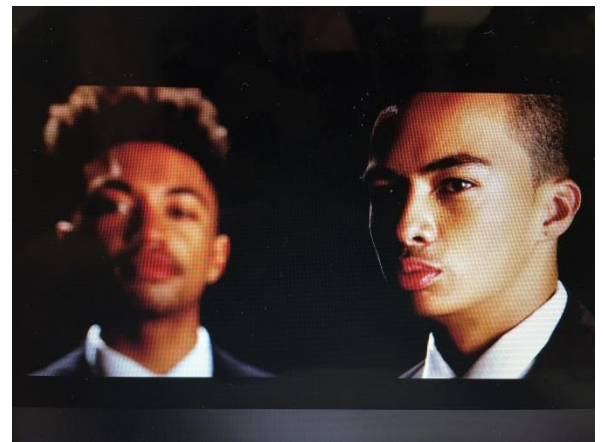
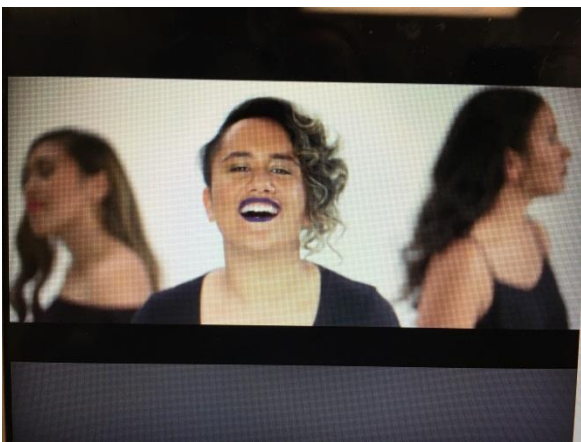
