School finishing early/Buses

On Friday 17 November 2017, school will be finishing at 1.50pm. All buses will be departing at 2pm.

Senior Prizegiving/Buses

The prizegiving is on Friday 17 November 2017, starting at 6pm.

The kura buses will return to pick the students up from their normal bus stops (exception of the Town bus run) and transport them back to kura for prize-giving. The buses will leave from their first bus stop as follows:

1. Northern bus - to depart Cnr of Clarkin & Bankwood Road at 4.30pm
2. Melville bus - to depart Odette Street at 4.15pm
3. Ngaruawahia bus - to depart Riverview Dairy at 4.45pm
4. Silverdale bus - to depart Caltex Service Station (Cambridge Road) at 4.30pm
5. Town bus - Not running

Whanau are required to arrange transport home for students after prize-giving.

For any further enquiries regarding the buses please contact the office.

It is compulsory for all Year 11-13 to return to kura by 5.30pm for prize-giving (meet in Whare Ora).

Please ensure your child has had something to eat prior to returning for the prize-giving.

All Year 11-13 taura, and any teina in kapa haka or the musical groups must come in their kākahu nama tahi to prize-giving, with boys being clean shaven.

Year 9-10 are not required to attend (unless in the performance groups on the night), but they are welcome to come along in mufti to tautoko with their whānau.

Students are not permitted to use cell phones or iPads etc to take photos as there will be a designated photographer at the venue. We ask that every effort be made by all attending to keep quiet during the prize-giving as the venue can get quite noisy.

As our big doors will be open, please bring warm clothing. Please have wet weather gear available.

In week 6, the Level 1 numeracy class will be involved in an intensive wānanga during Monday and Tuesday. This is not optional and if a student has not yet completed their numeracy they are expected to attend both days or until they have completed their mahi.
