### **Does your child have a sore throat?**

West Hamilton Pharmacy (next to Countdown at Nawton Mall) are offering free throat swabs to help identify strep throat.

The criteria are:

- Child has a sore throat
- Aged 4 to 19 years
- Living within Nawton, Huntly, Ngaruawahia or of Maori and/or Pacific decent

No appointment needed. Takes approximately 5 minutes. Tamariki to be accompanied by their parent or guardian.

If the results of the swab are positive antibiotics will be free.
