Important information for whānau of students sitting external examination

Kei te kōpuni kauika o tō tātou nei kaupapa – tēnā koutou.

Ko te kaupapa nui o te pānui nei ko ngā whakaritenga hei tautoko i ngā tuākana a tērā wāhanga. Ka timata ngā whakamātautau-ā-waho a te Wenerei, 7 Noema nō reira ka mutu ngā karaehe-ā-wātaka nei hei te

Turei, 6 Noema.

Hoinō, ka whakarite wānanga ngā kaiako tae atu ki te wiki tuawhitu (30 Noema) o tērā wāhanga, ā, **me tae a tinana atu te ākonga ki ngā wānanga e hāngai ana ki tana mātauranga.** Hei tauira, ka mutu ngā karaehe o ngā tau 13 a te Turei, 6 Noema erangi ka tū tā rātou whakamātautau Reo Rangatira a te Taite, 8 Noema, ā, mā Te Tari Reo Māori ētahi wānanga e whakahaere hei te Wenerei, 7 Noema.

Me mau te ākonga i ōna kākahu-ā-kura (ka tika) hei te wā ka haere ia ki ngā wānanga me ngā whakamātautau anō hoki. Me mātua tutuki te ākonga i āna whakamātautau katoa. Waihoki, ki te haere mai te ākonga ki te kura, mahi ai, me aronui ia ki āna mahi – haere ki te wānanga ki te Whare Mātauranga raini.

Hei te timatanga o tērā wāhanga tuku ai tātou i te wātaka wānanga.

Me manawa piharau, me manawa tītī te ākonga kia eke ai ki te tihi o Angitu.

We are writing to inform you of the preparations we have made to support our tuākana in their learning during Term 4.

Senior students will attend their timetabled classes up until the start of the external NCEA examinations. The last official day of timetabled classes for seniors is **Tuesday, 6 November.**

However, kaiako will be offering wānanga/tutorials through until week 7 of Term 4 (30 November) and **ākonga are expected to attend all relevant wānanga.** For example, Year 13 students' timetabled classes may finish on Tuesday, 6 November but their Te Reo Rangatira exam is on Thursday, 8 November and Te Tari Reo Māori will be holding wānanga on Wednesday, 7 November.

Ākonga must wear their correct school uniform when attending wānanga and whakamātautau. It is compulsory for students to attend all external examinations they are entered into. Furthermore, students who come to kura to revise must focus on their preparation – attend tutorials or study in the Library.

Te Waataka – Waahanga 4

Each marau will have a designated day for waananga. The waananga for a marau's scheduled day will take priority. It is compulsory for aakonga to attend their waananga times. If aakonga are not in a scheduled waananga, Oranga Wairua (O.W) and Oranga Tinana (O.T) times are to be used for independent study, a kaiako will be there to supervise.
