### PAID UNION MEETING – NEW ZEALAND POST-PRIMARY TEACHERS’ ASSOCIATION (PPTA)

**We have been advised that on Wednesday, 23 May, 2018, Ngā Taiātea Wharekura teachers will be required to attend a paid union meeting, starting at 1:30pm.** As a result of this meeting we will not have staff available for teaching classes but our school will remain open to care for students who are unable to be picked up by families, or who are unable to return home at this time.

**Buses will depart kura at 1pm.** Students who remain at school for supervision will be released to return home at 3pm. **There will be no additional school buses running at 3pm** and whānau will need to make alternative arrangements if required.

**On 23 May we ask, that if possible, all students are collected from kura at 1pm.** While we appreciate that for many parents/caregivers the timing of this meeting will cause some inconvenience we want to stress that the timing of these type of meetings is out of our control. We apologise for the inconvenience and thank you in advance for your support.
