For our Junior taura, kura will start at the normal time on Friday and the morning buses will run as per normal. Kura will finish at 12.55pm – all taura may go home then - buses leave at 1pm.

It is compulsory for all Tau 11-13 to be at kura by 5.00pm for Prize-giving (meet in Whare Ora). Please ensure your child has had something to eat prior to coming to the Prize-giving.

Tau 9-10 are not required to attend (unless in the performance groups on the night), but they are welcome to come along in mufti to tautoko with their whānau.

The kura buses will run in the late afternoon to pick students up from their usual stops and bring them to kura for prize-giving. Whānau from out of town may need to make alternative transport arrangements. Bus departure times as follows:

- Silverdale bus - 1st stop – Caltex Service Station, Cambridge Rd – 3.55pm
- Melville bus – 1st stop – 36 Pine Ave – 3.45pm
- Northern bus – 1st stop – Cnr Clarkin & Bankwood Rd – 3.55pm
- Ngaruawahia bus – 1st stop – Riverview Dairy – 4.15pm
- Transport Centre bus – Not running

It is the Whānau's responsibility to arrange for taura to be returned home at the end of the Prize-giving.

Tau 11-13 Taura & any teina in Kapa haka or the musical groups must come in their kākahu nama tahi to Prize-giving, with boys being clean shaven.

Taura are not permitted to use cell phones or iPads etc to take photos as there will already be a designated photographer at the venue. We ask that every effort be made by all attending to keep quiet during the Prize-giving as the venue can get quite noisy.
