HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Students travelling on buses to kura need to wear a face mask.
- Face masks are encouraged to wear at kura, however it is not mandatory in Level 2. (Face masks are available at the tari)
- Please keep your son/daughter at home if they are sick.
- If we notice any tauira who are sick or have Covid like symptoms we will contact the whanau to pick them up.
- All health and safety protocols at kura must be adhered to.
- Hand Sanitizer is available in all classes and the tari.
- Good hygiene practices are encouraged (posters are placed around the kura)
- QR codes placed around the kura to scan in students and Kaiako for contact tracing.
- Classroom windows and doors will be open for ventilation.
- All desks are wiped down after each class
- Teachers and Staff onsite have adhered to the Vaccine Mandate.
- Students will have scheduled classes for two weeks. After this period, our kura teina will focus on Tukuihotanga projects until the last day of the year (14th December).
- We have a school counsellor available (Matua Romana) for our tauira who need to talk.
- If you son/daughter has a school device, please return this on Monday 22 November.

Vaccination of students: There is no requirement for 12+ year old students to be vaccinated. However, as a school we are legally required to keep a record of students' vaccination status

Attendance and Absence from school

Student attendance is a major focus for our Senior Management Team. We acknowledge the majority of our taura who come to kura on time and ready for mahi. In recent weeks we have been having discussions with taura who are late and truant. We have contacted whānau so that we can address this kaupapa. Quite simply, attendance and achievement go hand in hand - if students are not here, they will not be able to do the best that they can.

We want all our students to achieve in all of our key focus areas, but we need them here so we can support them in their learning. This is also important for life. Whānau and employers need people who are reliable and can be trusted to be there when needed.

Looking forward to 2022 and letting whānau know now.

We are working closely with Te Koohao Health Attendance Services to address some of our student's attendance at kura and tautoko whānau to support our taura coming to kura.

Here is how we will work with the Attendance Services:

3 Days Unexplained absence Kura contact whānau to follow up on students. If there is no reply, then

- 1.) Referral to Attendance Services
- 2.) Attendance Services contacts with whānau and reports back to kura.

10 Days Unexplained absence During this time kura will try to contact whānau to come and hui. If there is no response, then truancy referral to Attendance Services

- 1.) Repeat Plan then Attendance Services meet with whānau and kura. Work with whānau to address the reason for absence (For example budgets, kai, travel)
